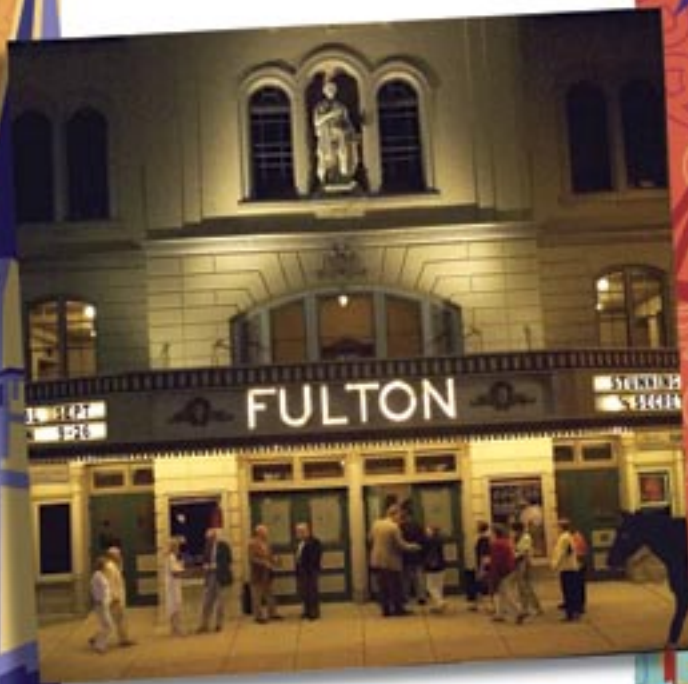
## Flavors of Lancaster

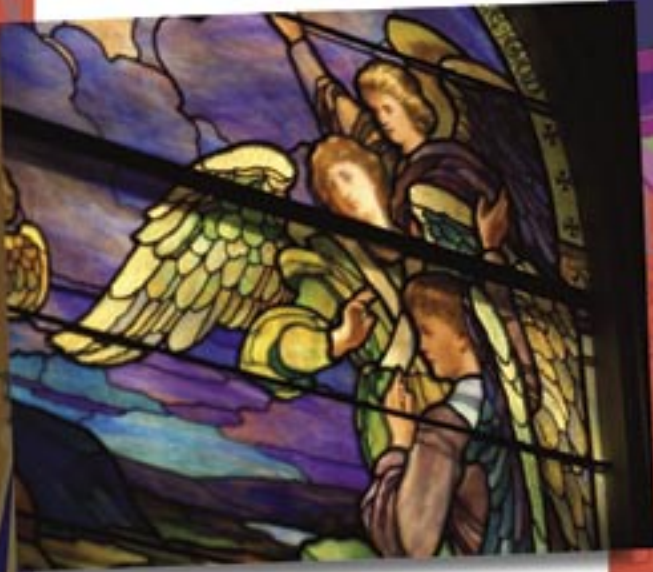


## Pubs, Prohibition & Piety
